A NRA Certified Range Safety Officer and an NRA Instructor will be on the Range while it is in use by the Scouts. The Range's Standard Operating procedures will be strictly enforced along with the Rules stated in The BSA Guide to Safe Scouting at all times during this activity.

By Law it is required that the Adult Uniformed Leaders of Troop 993 attending this activity be given permission by you to allow your son or dependent to handle and use a rifle and/or shotgun.
